

**ORDINANCE #2008-8: AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE STATESBORO
CODE OF ORDINANCES SECTION 6-193 REGARDING PAYMENT OF
EXCISE TAXES ON THE SALE OF MIXED DRINKS**

THAT WHEREAS, the City Council has previously adopted an ordinance regulating the payment of excise taxes on alcoholic beverages; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds sufficient reason and need to amend the current code section;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Statesboro, Georgia in regular session assembled that Chapter 6, Alcoholic Beverages, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Statesboro is hereby amended as follows:

Section 1. Amend Sec. 6-193 Payment to City to read as follows: “ On or before January 20th, April 20th, July 20th and October 20th of each calendar year, licensees shall be required to file with the city clerk an excise tax report showing the licensee’s gross receipts from the sale of mixed drinks and the amount of taxes collected or coming due thereon for the previous three months and shall pay over the amount due of taxes collected under this article to the city at the same time the excise tax report is filed.”


Section 2. Should any section, subsection, or provision of this ordinance be ruled invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, then all other sections, subsections, and provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. This ordinance shall remain in full force and effect from and after its adoption on two separate readings.


